**Sunday, September 24, 2023**, 10:45-5:30: We'll take the SF ferry to [Angel Island State Park](#), walk or shuttle to visit the Immigration Station, built in 1910 to enforce the Chinese Exclusion Act. Many Chinese fleeing poverty and natural disasters were detained there to be either granted entry or excluded and sent back to China. (Family and friends welcome).

*"I ate wind and tasted waves for more than 20 days. Fortunately I arrived safely on the American continent. I thought I could land in a few days. How was I to know I would become a prisoner suffering in the wooden building."*

May Angel Island today be a symbol of strength, resilience, and inclusion.
